- Outstanding items / Old Business
 - Storage Unit
 - We can use Tom's for the time being until at least October
 - Near Home Depot
 - Tom to coordinate getting stuff from Kerry
 - Survey status, Susan and Jim to update
 - Jim put the survey up
 - Everyone should link in their social media
 - Tom will try to put on SOMA Lounge if they allow
 - 55 responses in the first hour
 - No specific number of responses we are looking for or time limit when response rate plateaus, we can take it down
 - Update from the town
 - DPW
 - The town (Roger) doesn't think it would be a union issue to get a cheaper way to clean up
 - Police
 - We can negotiate with Chief of Police. He wants some presence but what it is specifically we can negotiate
 - He wants a township employee managing traffic and parking
 - He also may want a presence in the beer garden though regulations do not indicate that a police officer is required; just security
 - Jamie: There are 10 to 11 Auxiliary Police who are possible for support for the event and a way to lower costs
 - Need to schedule "Dept Head" meeting
 - Tom will send an email to ask for participants
- Committee reports
 - Operations Committee Susan Rogers
 - Reminder to review timelines
 - If anything looks wacky, please let Susan know
 - Budget Committee Tom Kerns/Gary Shippy
 - Budget assumed revenue down 30% and expenses static. Very conservative
 - Gary chasing sponsorships. Making some progress.
 - DCH at 8200. Slade at 4000. We have locked in 12 of the 14 more that Tom was planning.
 - About \$23k in the bank
 - Didn't plan on contributions from people
 - Assume Kid Zone would make limited money: 1800 vs 3100
 - Might need extra lights and trash cans, etc for the use of the other side of the park
 - Outsourcing updates
 - DPW
 - Susan researched some costs: estimate of \$2100 for people

- Could we use DPW dumpsters, garbage cans, etc only and we provide labor?
- o Could we use high school kids? Risk
- Police/Security

 - Liquor License may need another sponsor for the license. The state is not responding on all the back filings. Is there another not-for-profit that might sponsor the beer garden? Rotary? VFW? Cannot be the Elks.

 - Galactic is a go for Saturday
 - Will need to get contact info for tour manager for production company
 - Production company will be giving us a proposal any day now
 - We had to spend a little more money to secure them
 - Sunday ideas
 - We had agreed to Alan Paul with Friends of the Brothers
 - Junior Mac and Lamar Williams Jr will both be coming
 - Allman Brothers covers
 - \$3000 with possible travel costs
 - We have a few extra thousand bucks.
 - Another local band option called Funk Yea (Dave Persel). Some from Tower of Power. Available for \$2000
 - They gig / working unit
 - General agreement to move forward

 - Make a decision on design give feedback to Susan
 - Drop a second design the weekend of the event
 - Artwork discussion
 - Needs not to be a large print
 - Do we need the actual phone
 - Kid's design?
 - Jamie bring back the tree design without a date
 - Amount of merchandise to order
 - Tom wants to start an order see how sales might be going
